**SECTION ONE
DESCRIPTION OF CEMETERY**

**SECTION THREE

- B. The Cemetery reserves the right to erect buildings on any part of the cemetery; provided that any change will not affect the legal rights of owners of interment spaces or disturb the interred remains of any deceased person.
- C. The Cemetery reserves the right to use any part of the cemetery for any cemetery purpose or use connected with, or incident to the care, preservation, and preparation or interment of human remains; provided that any change will not affect the legal rights of owners of interment spaces or disturb the interred remains of any deceased person.
- D. The Cemetery reserves the right to maintain the cemetery land and structures and operate pipelines, conduits, and storm drains for sprinklers, drainage, and other similar purposes.
